Suggested Guidelines for the Policy Committee of the W.S.C.

The guidelines of the policy committee help the Fellowship as a whole to protect the Traditions.

We do not make policies for N.A. but help the Fellowship in keeping within our Traditions.

NOTE: THE TRADITIONS ARE THE POLICY OF N.A. AS A WHOLE.

The guidelines are as follows:

- 1. The Policy Committee willdiscuss policies in question, brought to this committee during the committee sessions.
- 2. The Policy committee will then draft a brief report on the policy(s) in question, (including all important points, pro-con).
- 3. The report will later be presented to the Conference for review and the recommendations of the Policy committee.
- The Policy committee will have at least two (2) meetings per year. One in Sept. and the second at least 3 months prior to the Conference.
- 5. The Chairman will be responsible for corresponding with the rest of the sub-committee members.
- 6. These guidelines can be changed or added to any time by the Conference of a 2/3 majority vote of the Conference.
