The large number of requests for H&I information has made apparent the need for a comprehensive network of H&I contacts. In conjunction with the World Service Conference H&I Committee, we will begin assisting H&I Committees and groups as an additional resource for communication and distribution. We will need to coordinate an active open line of communication with you and your committee.
