Enclosed you will find the complete PSA kit, including four color storyboards. Although a PSA kit has previously been provided to P.I. subcomittees and others who have ordered the videos, it did not include the printed stationary or the storyboards as they were not yet available. We wanted to be sure that every region got a copy of this finished product.

Please pass on the materials enclosed here to the appropriate P.I. chairperson or contact. If your committee or one of your subcommittees has purchased one of the T.V. spots prior to this date, they may call or write and request the new kit free of charge. PSA's shipped from this date forward will be accompanied by a PSA kit with the appropriate color storyboard.

If your committee desires, kits with all four color storyboards may be purchased without a PSA at a cost of \$4.00 plus shipping and handling. These kits can be helpful in your initial contact with local television stations. Some station managers will want to talk with you and look over the storyboards and scripts. After determining a station's desire to air one of the PSA's and the tape size they require, your actual video order will be mailed with another kit and storyboard. Blank stationary is also included in each kit for the letters your committee decides to use. Be sure to type your local address and phone contact in the lower, left corner.

In addition to the taped videos for use by T.V. stations, the W.S.O. also has the PSA's available on 1/2" VHS cassettes (all four spots on each cassette). Many regions have requested cassettes for use in P.J. workshops, learning days, etc. They may be purchased for \$10.00 plus shipping and handling.

Both the World Service Office staff and World Service Conference P.J. Committee are available at all times to help in any way we can. Please don't hesitate to call or write if you have any questions or concerns regarding P.J. activities.




# First Meeting—Hallway Scene

A bunch of drug addicts in a room together—gimme a break.




It is possible to stop doing drugs, the proof is at the meetings but you've gotta get there first.

I'd been running alone for so many years and now I wasn't, you know what I mean?





#### **Man In Phone Booth**




I remember how scared I was. I was desperate. I know I was desperate because I wouldn't have called otherwise.
